Akerman Represents QBex Computadores SA in \$100 Million Suit Against Intel Corp. Over Faulty Smartphone Chips, *Fortune* Reports

Akerman is representing Brazilian electronics brand QBex Computadores SA (QBex) in a \$100 million lawsuit against Intel Corporation (Intel). Filed in California federal court, the action charges that Intel provided Qbex with faulty microprocessors for its smartphone line, which caused phones to overheat, among other dangerous consequences.
