- Adoptions Project. Our professionals have collaborated with <u>Public Counsel</u>, the nation's largest public interest law firm, to develop a special pro bono project providing legal services to parents adopting children out of the foster care system.
- Law Firm Consortium on Children's Rights. - GI LAW Project. Akerman is proud to support the men and women serving our country and defending our freedoms by participating in the Governor's Initiative on Lawyers Assisting Warriors (GI LAW), a collaboration between the Florida Governor's office, the Department of Military Affairs, the Florida Department of Veterans' Affairs, and Enterprise Florida. Florida Governor Ron DeSantis introduced the GI LAW project to assist active duty military members by providing free legal representation in civil matters, filling the gap for Florida service members between legal assistance available through their military service and the civil legal needs with which military attorneys cannot assist service members. These services include matters such as family law matters, landlordtenant disputes, social security disability claims, contract disputes, help with unfair and deceptive sales and practices, bankruptcy matters, and wills and estates.
