Akerman Signs Anti-Defamation League Workplace Pledge to Fight Antisemitism

Today, Akerman Chairman and Chief Executive Officer Scott Meyers signed the Anti-Defamation League's Workplace Pledge to Fight Antisemitism. equity, equality, and inclusion that we as a law firm strive to uphold," continued Meyers.

Since the October 7 terrorist attacks on Israel, online calls for violence against Jews have risen by 1200 percent around the world. In addition, there has been a significant increase in antisemitic incidents in many different countries, including vandalism at synagogues; anti-Jewish rallies, graffiti (including swastikas), and hate speech (including "Gas the Jews"); and attacks on Jewish business establishments.
