Matthew Goldstein Authors *Reuters* Article on Congressional Concerns Over China Risk at U.S. Colleges and Universities

Akerman Government Affairs and Public Policy Partner Matthew A. Goldstein authored an article for *Reuters* regarding a 2023 end-of-year flurry of Congressional reports and pending bills focused on the Chinese Government's use of open research environments in the United States to circumvent export controls and other national security laws. These pending measures raise the potential for legislative changes that can significantly impact colleges and universities in 2024.
