Spencer Crowley Quoted in *Biscayne Times* on Urban Planning for Miami Public Walkway

Spencer Crowley was quoted in the Biscayne Times article titled, “It’s Time to Walk the Walk,” which details the City of Miami’s plans to construct a 15-mile public walkway along Biscayne Bay and the Miami River. Crowley, the Miami-Dade County representative of the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND), suggested that a continuous baywalk in the city’s core is immediately achievable, in light of his ongoing work constructing a baywalk at Museum Park. He is working with stakeholders to close gaps in the baywalk plan, one by one.

“I think we’re close to eliminating the last impediments in a central area, and the opportunity to achieve a connected baywalk is very real,” said Crowley. “Once Museum Park opens, we’re going to have something really great that will help convince people of the possibilities.”
