Gerald Cope Authors Article on New Appellate E-Records Rules for *Daily Business Review*

"Florida's appellate judges complain that they have trouble locating documents in the electronic record on appeal. That is a significant problem because appeals can succeed or fail depending on what is or is not in the record," Cope wrote in the *Daily Business Review*.
