Akerman Advises Amerant Bancorp Inc. on \$50 Million Senior Notes Offering

Akerman represented Amerant Bancorp Inc. (NYSE: AMTB) in closing its registered public offering of \$50 million aggregate principal amount of 7.00% Senior Notes due 2031.

Amerant Bancorp intends to use the net proceeds from this offering for general corporate purposes, which may include working capital, providing capital to support the organic growth of Amerant Bank, N.A., the Company's wholly-owned bank subsidiary, repaying outstanding indebtedness and repurchasing shares of the Company's Class A common stock under its stock repurchase program.

Raymond James & Associates, Inc. served as the sole book-running manager for the offering.

Amerant Bancorp, founded in 1979 and headquartered in Coral Gables, Florida, is a bank holding company providing individuals and businesses with deposit, credit, and wealth management services through its primary subsidiary, Amerant Bank, N.A., across 21 banking centers in South Florida and two in Tampa.
