New York Post Quotes Matthew Steinberg on Business Implications of Sexual Harassment

In a *New York Post* article titled, “Preventing Sexual Harassment Can Save Companies Millions,” WorkedUp podcast creator and host Matthew Steinberg discussed five ways in which sexual harassment can impact a company’s bottom line, including the potential for employee turnover and recruiting troubles, lower workplace productivity, company funding issues and consumer losses.
