# 2018 Legislative Session - A Sampling of Health Related Bills Filed

January 18, 2018

The 2018 Florida Legislative Session began its 60 day trek to completion on Tuesday, January 9, 2018. Both House and Senate will be debating various health related bills which may be of interest to healthcare providers in the State. The following is a sample of those bills which we feel are pertinent to our clients' practices and the patients/customers that they serve. In fact, many bills are never picked up in Committee and will not pass into law. Many more will be debated, but fail when voted on.
