ULI Honors Neisen Kasdin with Lifetime Achievement Award at 2019 Vision Awards

The Southeast Florida/Caribbean chapter of the Urban Land Institute honored Neisen Kasdin, Akerman Miami Office Managing Partner and a former mayor of Miami Beach, with the 2019 Lifetime Achievement Award for his impact in South Florida.
